Classroom Safety Rules:

The 4 Cardinal Rules of Firearm Safety

(Memorize these... these should become not only rules but a lifestyle)

- 1) Always Treat Every Firearm as if it is Loaded
- 2) Always Point Your Firearm in a Safe Direction Unless Defending Yourself or Others
- 3) Always Keep Your Finger Off of the Trigger (and up on the frame) Until You Are Ready to Fire
- 4) Always Be sure of Your Target and What is Beyond It

ALWAYS follow the 4 Cardinal Rules of Firearm Safety.

In the classroom, NO LIVE AMMUNITION IS ALLOWED. The only exception is the firearm and ammunition inspection which takes place upon your arrival. After the inspection, your firearm and ammunition you will return to your vehicle.

There will be display firearms available for viewing/demonstration... treat these firearms according to the 4 Cardinal Rules of Firearms Safety.

Under no circumstance are firearms to be handled/displayed during the classroom portion of the class (other than firearms provided by Practical Defensive Training LLC on display). This includes going out to vehicles to show your firearm to any other students.

When we go to the range to perform the live fire exercises firearms should remain in a case/bag or holster until it is your turn at the firing line. Do not remove the firearm from its container/holster until given the command by the instructor.

If at anytime during the class, you have a question about your personal firearm and need to display it, only do so under the direct supervision of the instructor.

Practical Defensive Training LLC Reserves the right to dismiss a student from the class if the student displays negligent or unsafe behavior in contradiction to the safety rules.

-Remember, these rules are put in place for your safety and for the safety of other students and the instructors.



Basic Logistics

Class starts at 8:30 am. There is a lot of material to cover, so please arrive on time. If all students are present early, we may even start early (and finish early).

Upon arrival, please bring your unloaded firearm (magazines should remain unloaded as well) and ammunition in with you, there will be a weapons and ammunition inspection. This is required by state law and ensures your firearm and ammunition function properly and safely for use at the range. Please keep your firearm in its case/container and let the instructor open and remove the firearm for inspection. This is done for the safety of the students and the instructors.

Remember to pack a lunch, drinks and snacks.

The classroom/lecture time required by Kentucky and Ohio is 6 hours; you may want extra drinks and snacks during this time.

We will travel to Shooter's Supply in Independence for the live fire exercises (directions are attached).

Please, do not wear open toe shoes... ejected brass from a firearm is quite hot and can burn you.

Please remember to bring eye and ear protection. If you do not have these, you may purchase them from Shooter's Supply when we arrive.

It is advisable to bring a hat. This will help shield you from ejected brass.

Bring Your Personal Handgun (if you do not own a handgun yet, please let us know ahead of time, and we can supply you with a loaner – you will have to provide ammunition or purchase ammunition from us)

Each student will need 50 rounds of commercially manufactured ammunition (no reloads allowed – this is a state requirement). If you cannot find ammunition in your specific caliber, please contact me; I may be able to help find the ammunition you are looking for.

Shooter's Supply can become quite busy in the later in the day, since many instructors use their facilities. In order to avoid the lengthy time it may take at the range during peak hours, we may choose to drive to the range for the shooting qualification after the first half of the class segment (which covers gun safety and basic shooting technique).



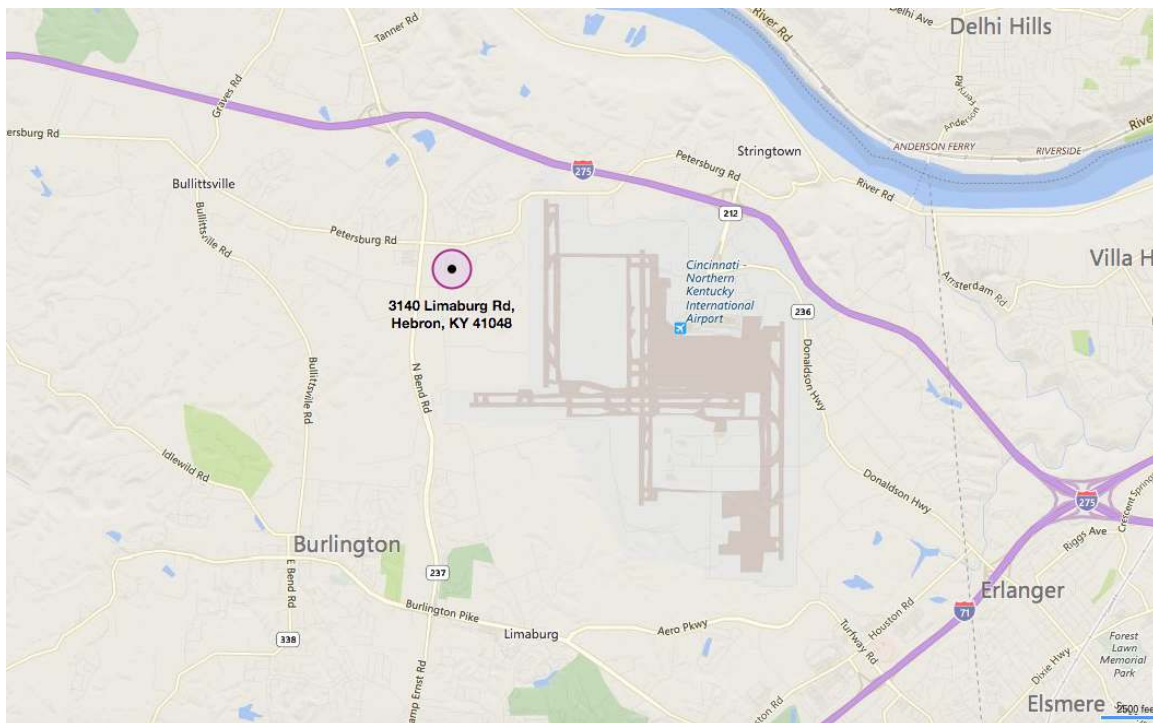

Class will take place in one of the lower level fellowship halls. Please park on the south side of the building (side with the large bell in front of the doors).

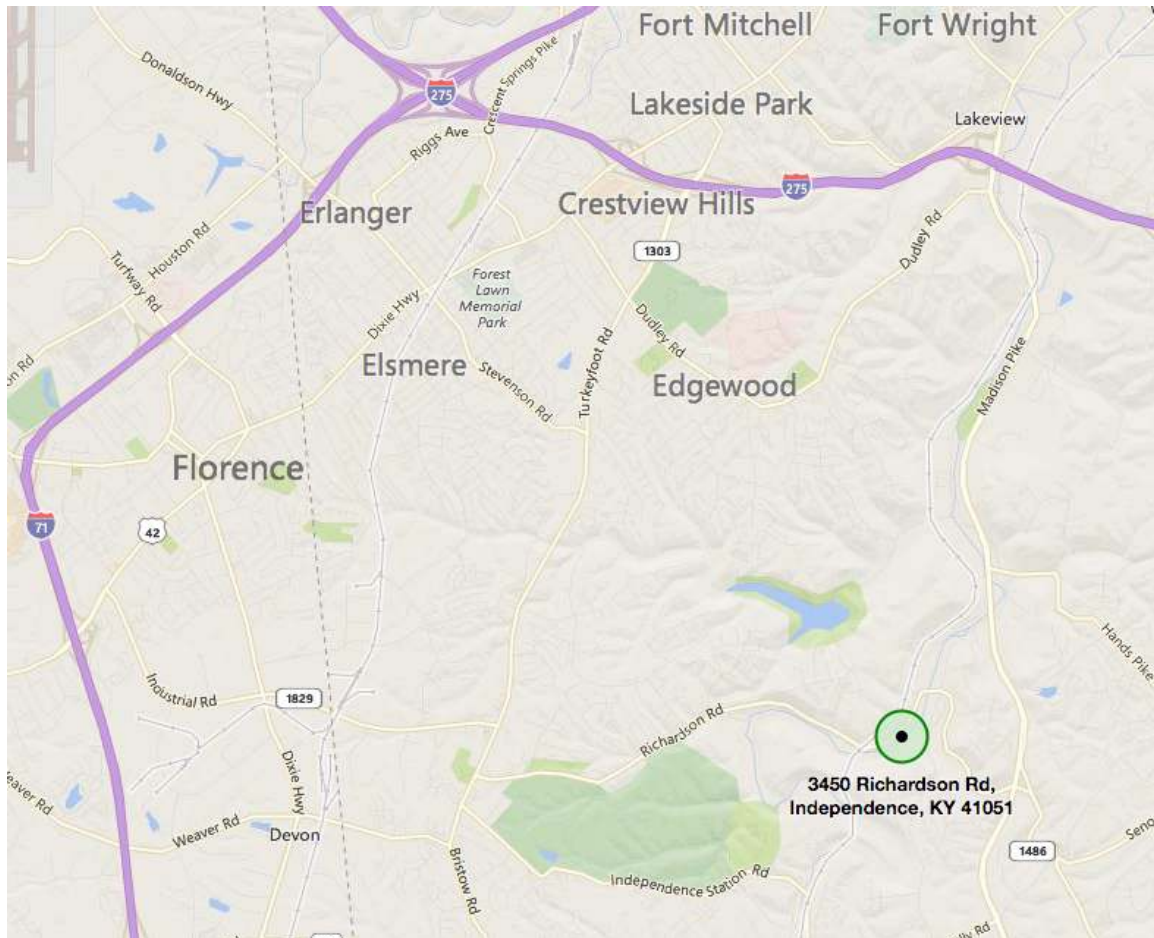
We will have fresh coffee and donuts available at the beginning of class.

Course Description:

Kentucky Concealed Carry of a Deadly Weapon (CCDW)

This course contains the required content from the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in compliance with KRS 237.110, a **Kentucky Resident** needs to apply for their Concealed Carry of Deadly Weapons (CCDW) permit.

Please note: This course is open to **Kentucky Residents** Only.

Course Cost is \$90.00

Students will need to bring to the Course:

- Personal Handgun (if you do not own a handgun yet, please let us know ahead of time, and we can supply you with a loaner – you will have to provide ammunition or purchase ammunition from us)
- 50 rounds of Factory Ammunition (no reloads – sorry, this is a KY State requirement)
- Eye and ear protection for the range.
- Lunch, snacks, beverages... this is 6 hours of class time, you will get hungry.
- Writing Implements and a notepad... note taking is highly encouraged.

Classroom time is approximately 6+ hours including the applicant written test. Live fire exercises will be held offsite at a local shooting range.

Ohio Concealed Handgun (CCW)

This is a course in which the student will receive a training certificate covering the requirements for Ohio CCW permit applications. This course contains the content required by the State of Ohio, in compliance with Ohio Revised Code section 2923.125 (G)(1), including a competency examination required by Ohio Revised Code 2923.125 (G)(2), an **Ohio Resident** needs to apply for their Concealed Carry of a Weapons (CCW) permit.

Please note: This course for the Ohio permit is open to **Ohio Residents** Only.

Course Cost is \$90.00

Students Will Need to Bring to the Course:

- Personal Handgun (if you do not own a handgun yet, please let us know ahead of time, and we can supply you with a loaner – you will have to provide ammunition)
- 100 rounds of Factory Ammunition (no reloads – sorry, this is a course requirement)
- Eye and ear protection for the range.
- Lunch, snacks, beverages... this is 8 hours of class time, you will get hungry.
- Writing Implements and a notepad... note taking is highly encouraged.



Classroom time is approximately 8 hours (as required by Ohio Revised Code) including the applicant written test. Live fire exercises will be held offsite at a local shooting range.
